## Museum Tower is cookin'

The next big thing on the high-rise residential scene is Museum Tower. Veteran Dallas developers **John Sughrue** and **Dan Boeckman** are erecting a 42-story modernist masterpiece — a spire of elegant residences on a prime plot in the Arts District right between the Nasher Sculpture Center and the Meyerson Symphony Center.

Chef *non pareil* **Stephan Pyles** is their culinary ambassador. The owner of the urbane Arts District eatery that bears his name, Stephan will be available to Museum Tower homeowners to create their ultimate kitchens.

He has a happy history with the developers. When he first opened his Ross Avenue restaurant, Mr. Sughrue and his company, Brook Partners, were his landlords. Last summer, however, Brook Partners sold Southwest Plaza, which also houses Mr. Sughrue's Fashion Industry Gallery, to **Ray Hunt**.

In other Pyles news, his restaurant has just begun off-site catering for seated dinners from 20 to 200 or cocktail parties up to 500.
